SPOT PAINTING



- Each Institute will be represented by 1 participant.
- Item will be conducted on the spot and participants will be requested to do painting on the subject given by the In-charge of the competition.
- Duration will not be more than 2 hours 30 minutes.
- Size of the painting will be half imperial size drawing paper i.e. 22 inches X 15 inches.
- Painting can be done in oil, water, poster or pastel colours.
- Candidates shall bring their own materials like brushes, paints, etc. Only the paper/sheet will be provided by the host institute.



CARTOONING



- Each Institute will be represented by 1 participant.
- Item will be conducted on the spot on the given subject/idea
- Duration will not be more than 2 hours 30 minutes.
- Participants shall bring their own materials. Only the Drawing paper 22" x 15" will be provided by the host Institute.



RANGOLI



- Each Institute will be represented by 1 participant.
- Duration will not be more than 2 hours 30 minutes.

- Participants shall bring their own materials.

This art is known differently in various regions such as Mandna, Alpana, Alekhan, Kolam, Rangoli, etc. For this, the medium and form for expression can be free hand, pictorial and descriptive. Only 1 medium shall be used Poster Colours or Flower Petals or Saw dust or Pulses or Rice without pasting.

- The Participants shall have to prepare a rangoli within the space provided by the organizers.
